- Improve the effectiveness of organizations to achieve unity of effort in the delivery of logistics outcomes.

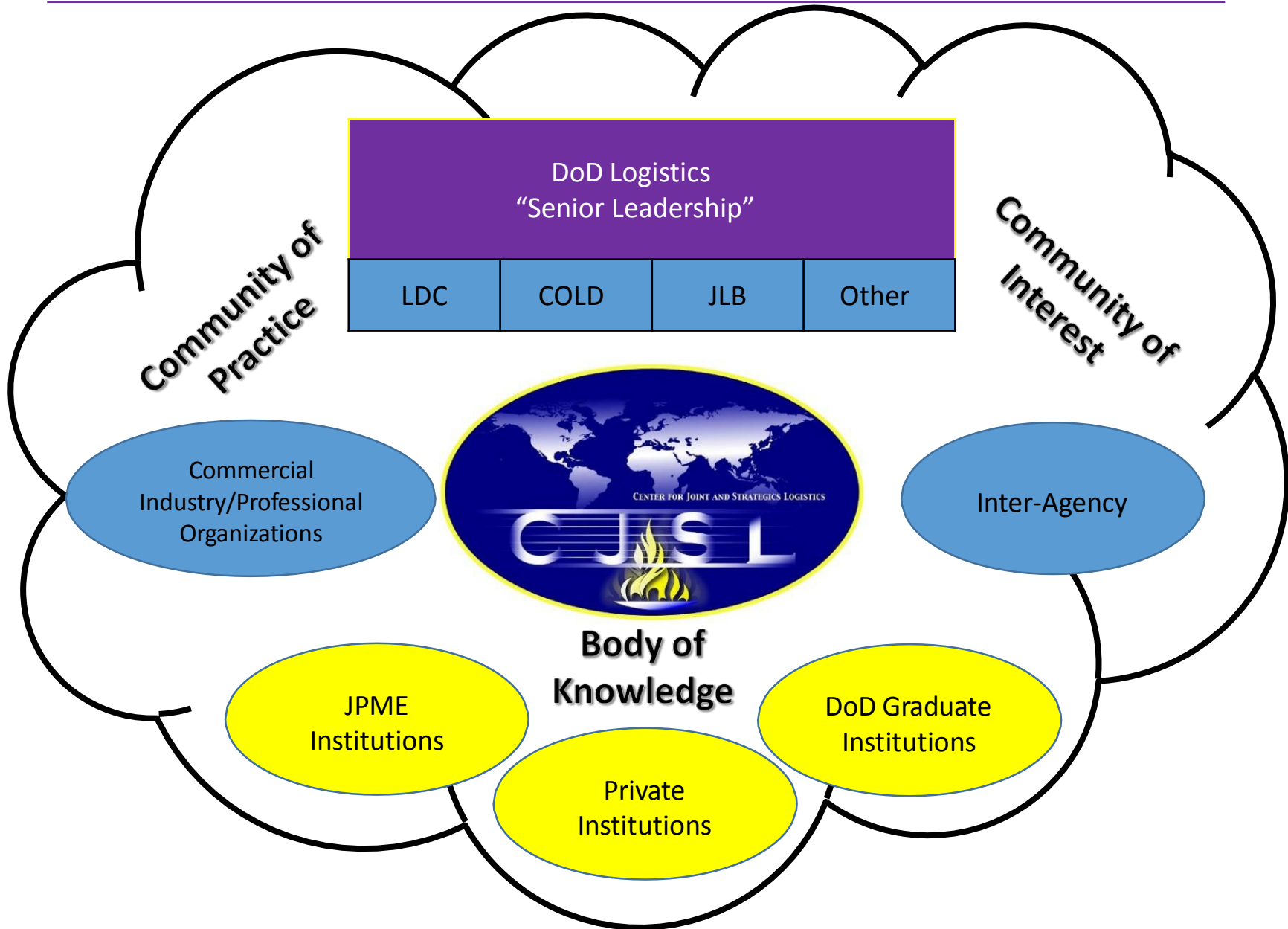
- **Leadership**

DoD Logistics Relationships



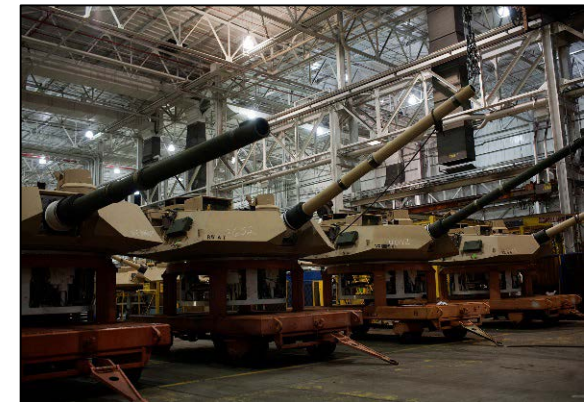
