Mission:

1) Shape logistics development efforts (i.e., education, training & exercises) to prepare Joint Force 2020 logisticians who are proficient in applying logistics support across the national security enterprise.

2) Help shape Joint Professional Military Education (JPME) curricula to enable non-logisticians to understand how joint logistics affects the development and execution of military strategy.

 - Influence the logistics learning continuum to produce logisticians that have the best opportunity for success in the contemporary and developing operational environments.
 - *Facilitate the shaping of joint logistics education, training, and exercises*
- Knowledge
 - Create a useable body of knowledge and a community of practice, and serve the logistics community as a ‘virtual coach’ whenever and wherever needed.
 - *Conduct annual Joint Logistics Faculty Development Workshop (Summer)*
