Who Can Attend?

The course is designed to educate logisticians enroute to or filling a combatant command or service component logistics billet.

- Military officers in the grades of O4-O7
- Non-commissioned Officers (E-8 to E9)
- DOD Civilians in the grade of GS-11 and above are eligible to attend.
- Lower grades may request a rank waiver, by submitting a formal request via memorandum from the first O5 in their chain of command.

The approval authority for a rank waiver is the Director of the Joint Logistics Course.

Knowledge Areas of JLC Graduates:

- Understand interdependent nature of joint logistics.
- Analyze use of service logistics to support joint military operations.
- Explain Joint Logistics Enterprise's (JLEnt) operational framework associated with Joint Command relationships and responsibilities.
- Comprehend practices, procedures, and processes that encompass the Joint Logistics Enterprise (JLEnt) to support operations in all joint environments.
- Analyze logistics capabilities and gaps to develop a Theater Logistics Overview that enables the Joint Force Commander freedom of action

About the Joint Logistics Course (JLC)

The Joint Logistics Course (JLC) sponsored by the Joint Staff J4 and is conducted over a four (4) week virtual classroom setting or a two (2) week resident class located at Fort Gregg-Adams, VA. The core curriculum prepares intermediate level officers, Senior NCO & DOD Civilian logicians to understand strategic organizations, authorities, and processes associated with the Joint Logistics Enterprise.

The course challenges students to apply joint logistics doctrine in a Joint, inter agency, and/or multinational context. Instruction includes Microsoft Teams webinars, guest speaker engagements, case studies, and practical exercises.

Educational Outcome:

JLC graduates will be confident and capable in applying their knowledge of organizations, authorities, and processes that comprise the Joint Logistics Enterprise (JLEnt*) in assuring both readiness and the planning and executing of support across the spectrum of competition.
