



CENTER FOR JOINT AND STRATEGIC LOGISTICS (CJSL) CHARTER

1. Purpose and Scope. The purpose of this document is to charter the Center for Joint and Strategic Logistics to shape the development of logisticians proficient in applying logistics support across the national security enterprise. This document supersedes the CJSL Charter dated 11 May 2010.
2. Authority. CJCSI 1801.01B, National Defense University Policy, dated 1 Apr 2009
3. Roles, Responsibilities, and Relationships.
 - a. Logistics Development Council (LDC).
 - 1) Chair. President, National Defense University
 - a) Provide a forum for the review of DoD logistics development policies, procedures, and programs
 - b) Establish administrative and procedural guidelines for the LDC
 - 2) Members
 - a) Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense for Logistics and Materiel Readiness (PDASD(L&MR))
 - b) Joint Staff Director for Logistics (DJ4)
 - c) Director, Defense Logistics Agency
 - d) Deputy Commander, USTRANSCOM
 - e) Army, G4
 - f) Air Force, A4
 - g) Navy, N4
 - h) Marine Corps, Installations and Logistics
 - i) U.S. Coast Guard, Engineering and Logistics
 - 3) Provide integrated logistics guidance and direction to the CJSL
 - 4) Advise the Joint Logistics Board on logistics development issues
 - b. CJSL.
 - 1) Execute actions and tasks directed by the LDC
 - 2) Provide support for strategic decision making, as requested
 - 3) Gather/analyze data and make recommendations on logistics development initiatives
 - 4) Conduct research, provide analysis and make recommendations to the LDC
 - 5) Establish a Council of Logistics Advisors (CLA). The CLA will:

- a) Be comprised of senior members from Academia, Industry and/or the Department of Defense
 - b) Be tasked to advise/provide input to the Center on logistics development initiatives and recommendations
 - 6) Establish a Secretariat for the LDC.
 - a) Coordinate meetings
 - b) Document and disseminate decisions on LDC issues and recommendations
- c. Key Relationships.
- 1) Logistics Community of Practitioners (LCoP).
 - a) The LCoP will work together within the logistics community to share information, experiences and lessons learned. The LCoP should:
 - 1. Develop and maintain policy and doctrine
 - 2. Facilitate the transfer of lessons learned
 - 3. Retain and grow technical expertise
 - 4. Partner with other organizations to advance logistics initiatives
 - b) The LCoP is comprised of members of the following Organizations:
 - 1. ASD (L&MR)
 - 2. The Joint Staff (J4), Logistics Directorate
 - 3. The Joint Staff (J7), Operational Plans and Joint Force Development
 - 4. DLA
 - 5. USTRANSCOM
 - 6. USJFCOM
 - 7. Service Logisticians
 - 8. COCOM Logisticians
 - 9. US Army Corps of Engineers
 - 10. Interagency Partners
 - 11. Multinational Partners
 - 2) Logistics Community of Interest (LCoI)
 - a) The LCoI will interact with the LCoP and within the logistics community. The LCoI may be:
 - 1. Stakeholders
 - 2. Potential customers
 - 3. Influencers
 - b) The LCoI is comprised of members from:
 - 1. PME Institutions
 - 2. Logistics Civilian Academic Institutions
 - 3. Industry
 - 4. Professional Associations (i.e. National Defense Transportation Association (NDTA), National Defense Industrial Association (NDIA), etc.)



- b. The CJSL will provide periodic updates to the JLB, as needed/requested


